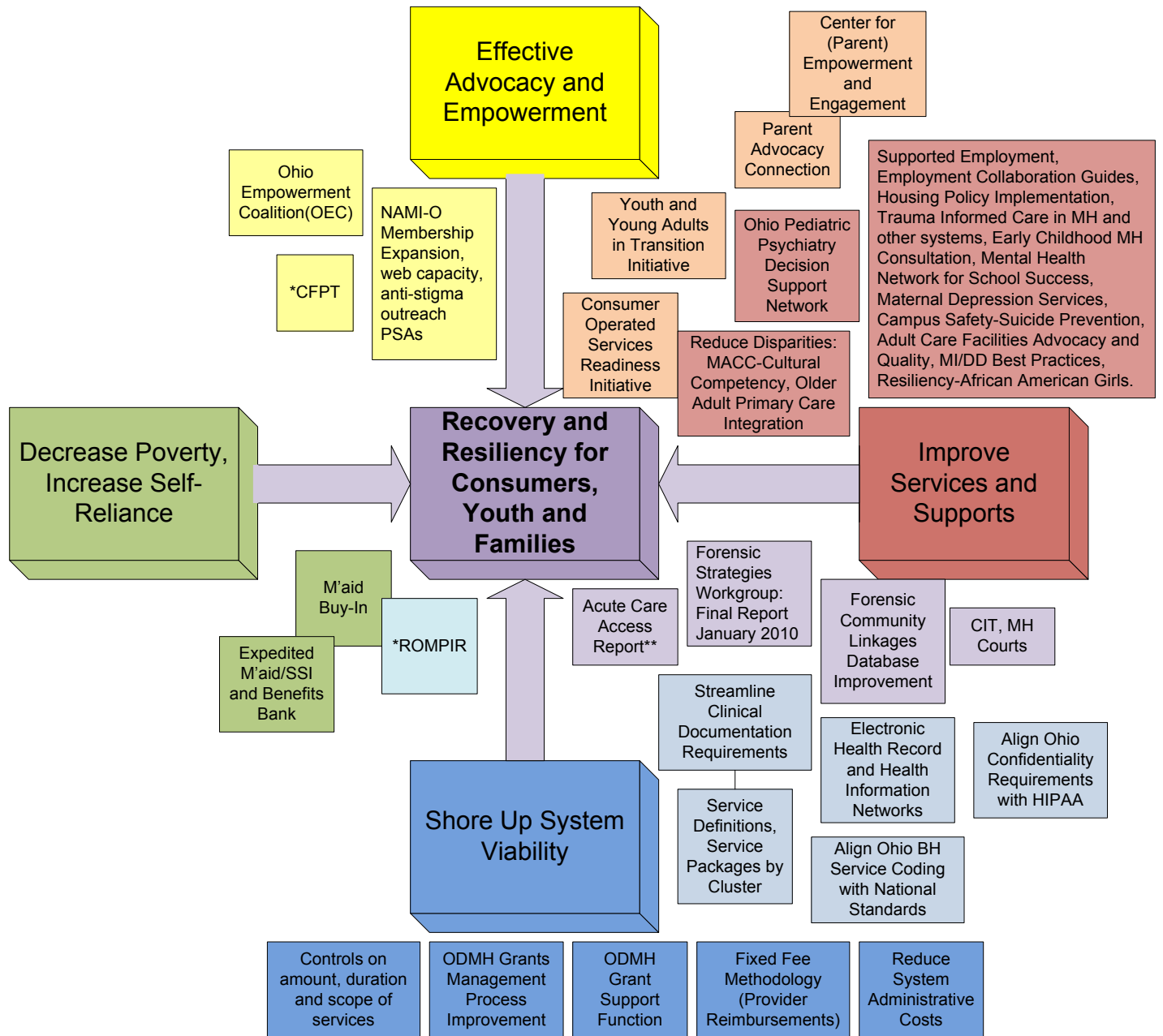

- CFPT: Consumer and Family Policy Task Force, responsible for developing and implementing statewide policy and program, working groups and receive cost reimbursement and a capex.
- COSRI: Consumer-Operated Services Readiness Initiative, the activity designed to assist COS organizations to operate on a business model in which they can be eligible to receive state-controlled funds in the future.
- ROMPIR: Reinstatement of Medicaid for Public Institution Recipients, the collaborative effort to restore Medicaid cards to patients or inmates upon discharge or release in order to improve continuity of care and benefits.
